Did you know?

- CF is the most common life threatening, recessive genetic condition affecting Australian children.
- CF Affects a number of organs in the body (especially the lungs and pancreas) by clogging them with thick, sticky, mucus.
- Repeated infections and blockages can cause irreversible lung damage and death.
- Mucus can also cause problems in the pancreas preventing the release of enzymes needed for the digestion of food.
- There is no cure for CF, however with improved treatment and medications most people with CF are able to lead reasonably normal and productive lives.
